


## VINICULTURAL SOCIETY

2016 Petite Sirah Sonoma Valley

he Buena Vista Vinicultural Society, formed in 1863 by the winery's founder, Count Agoston Haraszthy to further improve its winemaking prowess and expand its vineyards, has been restored as a collection of unique small-production wines that honor the winery's pioneering spirit and contribution to California winemaking.

The Vinicultural Society explores clonal selections, varietals and the incredible terroir of Sonoma County. In keeping with the adventurous spirit of Buena Vista's founding, we are proud to bring you this delicious 2016 Karoly's Selection Petite Sirah.



Named for Count Haraszthy's father who spent much of his adult life following his passion for wine from cultivating vineyards to selling wine - Karoly's Selection Petite Sirah celebrates this unique varietal hailing from Southern France. Typically used as a blending grape, this dark, intense berry has strong tannins and dark fruit flavors.

An opulent deep purple in the glass, our 2016 Karoly's Selection Petite Sirah offers enticing aromatics of raspberry, dried blueberries and a complimentary pencil lead note. Big round tannins with a richly textured mouthfeel, this wine showcases flavors of raspberry and dark cocoa with a touch of strawberry. Dense and well-balanced with soft tannins and a juicy structure, this commanding wine pairs well with roasted meats or a traditional Hungarian goulash.
